



Child safety and internal window blinds

SHY has supported the British Blind and Shutter Association's 'make it safe' campaign since it was launched in 2009.

All of SHY's products can be supplied with gearbox or motorised operation which are inherently child safe. For chain operated blind systems SHY (UK) provide compliant tensioning devices (to BS EN 13120:2009+A1:2014) which, when correctly installed, ensure that the chain is held taut and so remove an unrestrained loop.

Changes to child safety standards

The British Standards Institute published a revision to the child safety standard, including two test method standards, on 28 February 2014. These standards affect blinds in any premises where children between 0-42 months are present or likely to have access. Consequently, this affects all homes, public buildings and the publicly accessible areas of commercial buildings.

When ordering we suggest you use our order/measure forms to ensure you allow for child safety requirements. Don't forget, we also supply other forms of hand-operated blinds, or electric controls.
